I see your needs, yet your actions deny it.

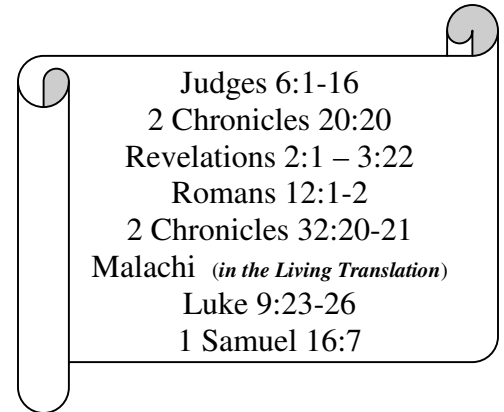
I am the Lord and I change not.

The Vision is great, but so are your needs.

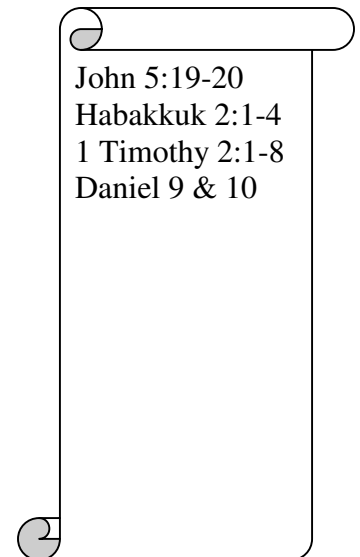
Until I’m given the lead, you will


Consider your ways,

For many to seek.



A storm is near and it's very fierce.


Where are my mighty men of valor whom I seek?

Like a great fish must I swallow and spew you to your land of destination?



Saith the Lord.




Hebrew 12:1-17
